- Never punish or belittle a child for losing or making mistakes.
- Never force your child to take part in sport.
- Support your child by paying their fees promptly, arriving on time for training sessions/matches and making sure your child has the appropriate safety kit as deemed by the coaches.
- Support your child's involvement and help them to enjoy their sport.
- Use correct and proper language at all times.
